Who we are

We are a refugee-based non-government organisation that is managed and governed by refugees.

We bring together 12 refugee communities in the Wellington region.

We are unique nationally and internationally, bringing together peoples from different ethnicities, religions and nationalities.

What we do

We run capacity building programmes for refugee communities and their leaders.

We research and advocate for the interests and concerns of refugee communities at local and national levels.

We work with government and non-government agencies to ensure that they effectively address the issues of refugee resettlement.

We founded and provide ongoing support to the National Refugee Network to connect and inform refugee communities around New Zealand.

What we have done so far: some examples

Support For Community Leaders

We provide ongoing training and mentoring support for community leaders.

Action Plan

We have developed and continue to coordinate the Wellington Regional Action Plan for Refugee Health and Wellbeing. This includes over 50 projects involving communities, government and non-government organisations.

Standards For Engagement

We have written Standards for Engagement to ensure agencies working with refugee-background communities do so effectively and respectfully.

Speakers Bureau

With a grant from the UNHCR, we have set up professional training and support for former refugees to tell their stories to a variety of audiences. Please contact us if you are interested in booking a speaker for a meeting or event.

Youth

We run projects which build the skills and confidence of refugee-background youth (13 to 29). We also advocate for refugee youth issues, and support them to participate fully in Wellington life.

Women

We run projects which build the skills, confidence and participation of women in their own communities and in the wider community.

Refugee Communities Newsletter

We provide regular newsletters to communities to inform them of our events and opportunities of interest to them.

Drama

We have produced a drama on building strong families in New Zealand which was performed for communities in February 2009. It is now available in DVD format to enable ongoing viewing and discussion of the issues by communities.
